

Chronologies of the Yaa-Naas of Dagbon

The sources of these dated chronologies of Yaa-Naas' reigns are: Brigitta Benzing, *Die Geschichte und das Herrschaftssystem der Dagomba* (Meisenheim am Glan: Verlag Anton Hain, 1971); and Phyllis Ferguson, *Islamization in Dagbon: A Study of the Alfanema of Yendi* (Ph.D. dissertation, University of Cambridge, 1972). The chronologies employ approximate dates based on "distributive" systems that work by assuming an average length of reign (15 years) and also by projecting backwards from "fixed" dates based on comparative historical data. The estimates of average reign are probably low, and the earlier dates could possibly be pushed back a bit further, based on chronologies of the founding of the Tenkodogo Mossi. See Elliott P. Neither Benzing nor Ferguson lists chiefs before 3ipopora. Asterisks indicate "fixed" points in Ferguson's chronology.
